YOUR SHORT MANUAL TO FIND YOUR WAY AROUND THE PLATFORM









The first thing you have to make to be able to participate in a hackathon event is to register in the platform.

You have 2 ways to access the platform registration.

- I. Pressing the "here" link that will get you straight to the user registration form or,
- 2. Select "Registration" from the sidebar menu. On the registration page, choose "User" to access the form.










Here you need to fill the required fields.

Important: Select a category. Open the INVITE dropdown menu under Category and choose Hackathon.

This will help on an initial filtering of available materials on the platform based on your interests.

When you finished press the "Registration" button










After clicking "Registration," screen (1) will appear, and a verification email will be sent to your provided address. Open the email and follow the instructions to verify. Clicking the link will take you to a page like screen (2).

You can then click the "here" button navigate back on the home page. 2



Your account has been activated.



LOGIN THE PLATFORM



Now, you should be able to login the platform by filling your username and password on the "User login" form.










This is your main page, where all your registered hackathons and courses will appear. Initially, your portfolio will be empty. Let's add some!

You can do this by pressing the "Course Registration" (1) or the "OER-Hackathon List" on the left side bar (2).








COURSE SELECTION

On the course selection page, you can browse and register for courses and hackathons.

The screen shows events and materials from your selected category by default, but you can go back (I) to page (A) to choose another category.

To register, check the box (2) next to your event. To explore, click the event to visit its page (3).








EVENT REGISTRATION THROUGH ITS PAGE

If you choose to explore the event page before registering, you can register directly from there by clicking the "Register" (I) button.

Note: You must be logged into the platform for the "Register" option to appear.














"Agenda" is an information visualization in the form of a Calendar.

You can see all the actions, important tasks, and upcoming sessions of the Hackathon event










You can see all the announcements of the event.






FORUM



You can access the forum to visit your group's notes, and discuss with your teammates, or you can ask support from the technical team or the hackathon hosts.






GROUPS



You can access your group, and share documents or check your teammates






MESSAGES



You can send a personal message directly to someone from the hosts, mentors, and administrators.










Probably the most important page of the event. You can access it even if you're not logged in. It includes all available materials, such as participant guides, educational content on the topic, and more.






WALL

If logged in, you can also like or comment on the content hosted here.










UNITS & NEWS

The hackathon event is divided into Units. Numbers 4, 5, and 6 represent the different states of a Unit. If a Unit is light grey, it means it is inactive for you.







UNITS

Units contain specific information and tasks based on their title. For example, the "Complete Registration" Unit requires participants to provide additional information to proceed.

Each Unit may be structured differently according to Hackathon's needs, so be sure to review them carefully. Also, check the "Participant's Toolbox" for important details.

Don't Forget to check the progress icons on each task and Unit
